

# MVCA 2nd Graders Final

## CHECKLIST

- Attend final DIBELS testing.  
DIBELS 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter - Score goals DORF(word per minute **87**, retell 97% which means retelling the story in sequential order, as well as listing the characters and setting! Student should use at least 27 words in the retell process.
- Check My Info in the OLS to ensure your email and phone number are correct for the school to get in touch with you next year. <http://help.k12.com/support-topics/account-information/update-your-contact-info/account-information-how-update-your-email>
- Complete your required percentage of OLS lessons by JUNE 13<sup>th</sup>.** All lessons must be completed by this date for teachers to mark grades and move students to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Students are required to work 5 days a week 6 ½ hours a day until the very last day of school, June 13<sup>th</sup>.
- Fill in any missing attendance.** Be sure your hours are a total of **1108**. Be sure to have attendance in each subject, including PE, Health, and Technology (which required 50 hours).
- Contact your teacher if you have any questions or concerns about the end of the year requirements or advancing to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- Reregister for 2015-16 school year. This is found under My Info on your OLS. To the left you will see a register now button. Even if you are undecided I highly recommend you register. It is much easier than redoing the registration process in the fall.
- Complete NWEA MAP Test.
- Watch your **email** for the shipping labels to mail your material back to K12. If you have questions about this please call K12 tech support. 1-866-512-2273
- Continue to work in Iready and Reading Eggs at least 20 minutes each night.
- Attend final DIBELS conference with your teacher.
