The 2nd Grade team of teachers are here to get you to 3rd grade smoothly! Please take note of the following notes. Reach out to your homeroom teacher if you have questions.

Writing/Science/Social Studies:

- There will be NO more writing classes (skills or remediation).
- There will be NO more Science & Social Studies classes
- It is your responsibility to complete any lessons you may have left in the OLS.

Curriculum Map:

- April will be your last curriculum map.
- The months of May and June we will begin to review and expose students to some 3rd grade material.
- We will give you the lesson to mark complete at the end of each lesson.
- All classes are still required and count towards 10% of your grade!

NWEA: End of the year is your time to shine! It is a time for you to show off all your hard work and how far we have come! Spring testing is required for all students. **The 2nd grade dates are May 2nd & 3rd.**

Your student will attend one of the REQUIRED session each day. May 2nd Reading you can come at 9am OR 12pm. May 3rd you can come at 9am OR 12pm.

Please plan to attend NWEA orientation April 28th at 2pm. We will make sure your computer is working and run through what to expect for those who are new.

L.C. to do list:

- * Make sure your student gets a good night's sleep and is fed before testing.
- * Choose a session when your student is most focused. For example if your student is a morning person and does his/her best work at that time then come to the morning session.

- * Talk to your student:
 - It is important to do your best possible job. It is time for you to show off how far you have come!
 - The 3rd grade teachers will be looking at these testing results to form their reading and math groups for the start of next school year. In order to do this, they need accurate data of where you are at.
 - It is crucial that you take your time. Any student who finishes in less than 20 minutes will be asked to retake the test.
 - It is not for a grade so relax. Take your time and just do your best. If you have to, make your best guess and move on.
 - You can take short breaks when needed.

Boot Camp: NWEA Prep!

- It is mandatory students attend NWEA Boot Camp!
- These sessions will be held the **week of April 18th for math and April 25th for reading.**
- You will have a session each day at **9am AND 12:30pm.**
- You will be divided according to your RIT score (NWEA). You will get individual instruction based on your test data.
- These sessions will give you a review and boost for completing your NWEA testing.
- You may or may not have your homeroom/small group teacher for these sessions.
- Please attend and participate. Attendance will be taken and go towards your overall grade!
- If you have a case manager she will be in touch with you to confirm your schedule for those two weeks.



DIBELS is an end of the year reading test that is REQUIRED of all 2nd grade students. Start practicing now! You can visit our 2nd grade website <http://mvcagrade2.weebly.com/dibels.html> and your file share for details. We are also progress monitoring during reading group sessions (this is a 1 minute practice session) to help students increase their fluency rate.

- Mrs. Lasky's class will be doing DIBELS testing the week of May 9th.
- Mrs. Fuller, Mrs. Carrie & Mrs. Blanchard's DIBELS testing will be the week of May 16th.
- If you work with an interventionist you will be DIBELS testing the week of May 16th.



If you are behind this is the time to start catching up! Please see the catch up document in your file share for tips. You may also be excited to hear our administrative team has received approval from K12 to move your course completion percentage expectation from 100% to 80%. This will instantly improve your course grades, improve your pace requirements, and workload! It will allow you to slow down when needed and take time to work in iReady or Reading Eggs. However, if you are behind this is not permission to slack...you still have to catch up! This really is permission for those who are on target to slow down a bit here at the end of the year. PLEASE NOTE!!! To move onto a new course early, before the end of the school year, you must reach 100% in said course. The deadline for teachers to order any new courses for this year is April 29th.

We know the end of the year can be overwhelming, but don't panic! We've got ya! We will be in touch and staying in strong communication with you. All of these test sessions will be on your daily plan. So keep completing the daily plan and you will be good to go to 3rd grade! 😊
